



# **DOMESTIC VIOLENCE COUNTS REPORT**GUAM SUMMARY

On September 4, 2024, **4** out of **4 (100%)** identified domestic violence programs in Guam participated in a national count of domestic violence services conducted by the National Network to End Domestic Violence (NNEDV). During the 24-hour survey period, participating programs served **43** victims and shared the following additional information.

#### 43 Victims Served

**27** adults and children found refuge in emergency shelters, transitional housing, hotels, motels, or other housing provided by local programs.

**16** adults and children received non-residential supportive services like transportation, court accompaniment, counseling, and more.

#### **4 Hotline Contacts Received**

Domestic violence hotlines are lifelines for victims in danger, providing support, information, safety planning, and resources via phone, chat, text, email, and more. Programs' hotlines received **4** contacts.

## **O People Educated**

While programs did not provide educational sessions during this period, addressing topics like domestic violence prevention and early intervention are important throughout the year.

### **O Unmet Requests for Services**

While programs did not report any unmet requests during this period, there is still a tremendous need for increased funding to ensure programs can provide comprehensive services to all survivors seeking help while working toward preventing violence in their communities.
