



## WomensLaw at a Glance: 2024 National Updates

WomensLaw.org offers plain-language legal information for 55 states and territories, federal legal information, and non-legal information related to domestic violence. To provide the most updated information to survivors, their loved ones, and the professionals who help them, the WomensLaw team reviewed amendments to **451 statutes** and added **475 new statutes** in 2024. Based largely upon these new and amended statutes, we created **393 new questions and responses** and revised an additional **798 existing questions and responses** on WomensLaw.org. We also translated more than **1,489 pieces of content** into Spanish and **10** into Korean. In our Places that Help section, we added **258 new state-specific and national resources** and updated **844 existing ones**.
