MEMBERSHIP INFORMATION

Criteria for Membership as a Full Member Agency

- the organization's mission must be focused on ending domestic violence in Rhode Island
- the organization must provide a comprehensive range of services to victims of domestic abuse: residential services (i.e. shelter, transitional or permanent housing), support services, court services, and crisis intervention
- applicants for Full Membership are required to have been Affiliate Members for three years
- applicants must demonstrate that they are meeting an unmet community need, without duplicating existing services for victims of domestic violence
- applicants must have letters of support regarding their membership application from at least 51% of the existing Full Member Agencies of the Coalition
- applicants must demonstrate fiscal viability

Benefits and Responsibilities of Full Member Agencies

- Full Member agencies have a voting seat on the Coalition's Board of Directors, and are required to actively participate on the Board and at least one of its committees
- Full Member agencies share in the allocation of funds that pass through the Coalition to its Full Member Agencies
- Full Member agencies receive benefits such as free borrowing privileges from the Resource Library, receipt of donated material goods as available, invitations to in-service trainings and educational forums for staff and volunteers, monthly mailings of

discounts for Coalition-sponsored conferences and events, free subscription to Helplink.

<u>Criteria for Membership as an</u> <u>Affiliate Agency</u>

- a portion of the agency's programming must be focused on working with domestic violence victims
- applicants for Affiliate Membership are required to have been in existence for a full year since the date that they filed for their 501-c-3 status
- applicants must demonstrate that they are meeting an unmet community need, without duplicating existing services for victims of domestic violence
- applicants must have a letter of support regarding their membership application from an existing Full Member Agency
- applicants must demonstrate evidence of cooperation with the local Full Member Agency in their geographic area
- applicants must demonstrate fiscal viability

Benefits and Responsibilities of Affiliate Member Agencies

- Affiliate Member agencies are welcome to attend Coalition Board meetings and to participate on various committees
- Affiliate Member agencies have the opportunity to participate in statewide grant proposal submissions that are generated by the Coalition (for any new funding sources)
- Affiliate Member agencies receive benefits such as free borrowing privileges from the Resource Library, receipt of donated material goods as available, invitations to inservice trainings and educational forums for staff and volunteers, occasional mailings of state-of-the-art research and information, e-mail alerts, access to technical assistance and information from Coalition staff, discounts for Coalition-sponsored conferences and events, free subscription to Helplink.

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
