



# DOMESTIC VIOLENCE COUNTS

## Northern Mariana Islands Summary

On September 14, 2016, **100%** of identified domestic violence programs in the Northern Mariana Islands participated in the National Census of Domestic Violence Services. The following figures represent the information provided by these participating programs about services provided during the 24-hour survey period.

### 67 Victims Served in One Day

**66** domestic violence victims found refuge in emergency shelters or transitional housing provided by local domestic violence programs.

**1** adult and child received non-residential assistance and services, including counseling, legal advocacy, and children's support groups.

### 9 Hotline Calls Answered

Domestic violence hotlines are a lifeline for victims in danger, providing support, information, safety planning, and resources. In the 24-hour survey period, local and state hotline staff answered **9** calls.
