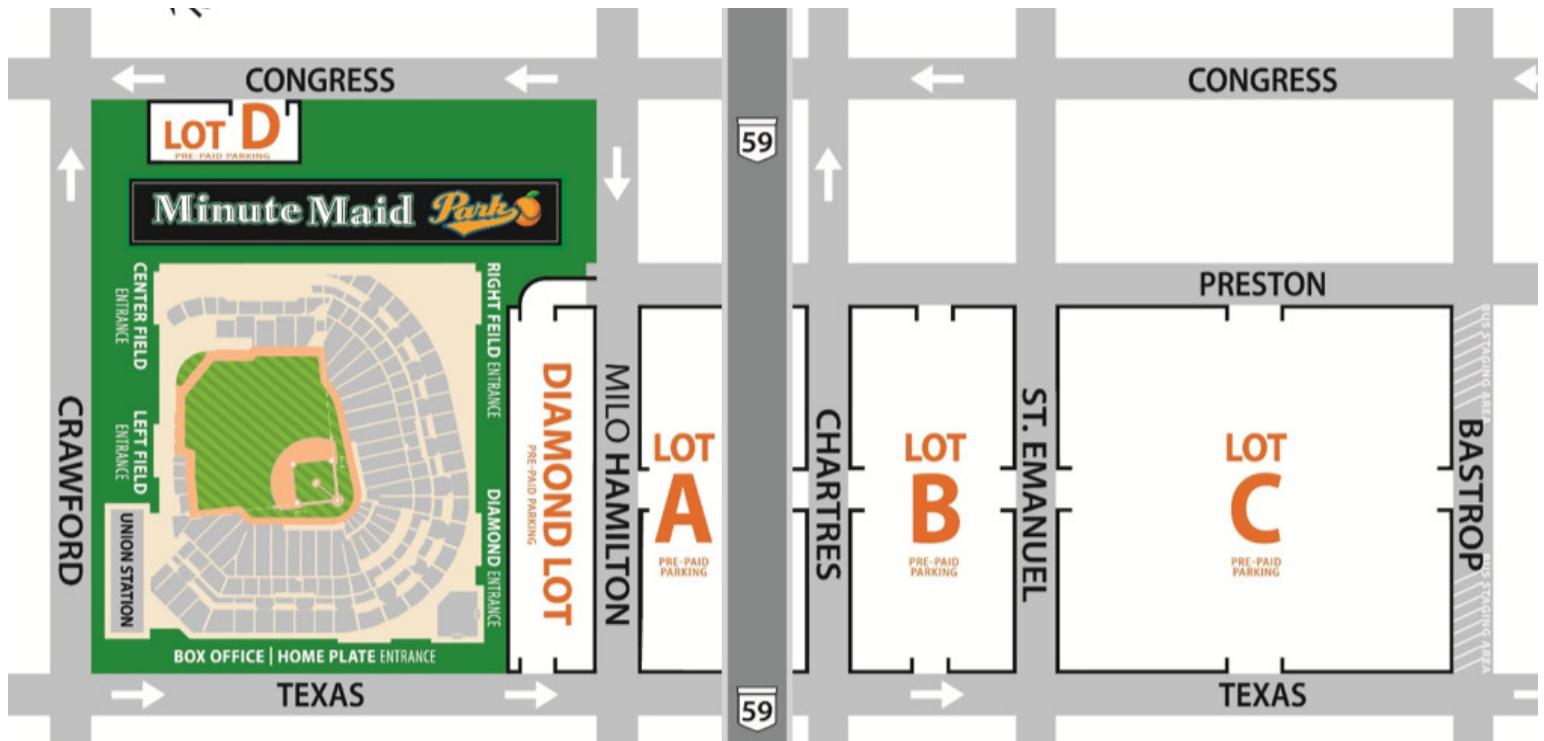

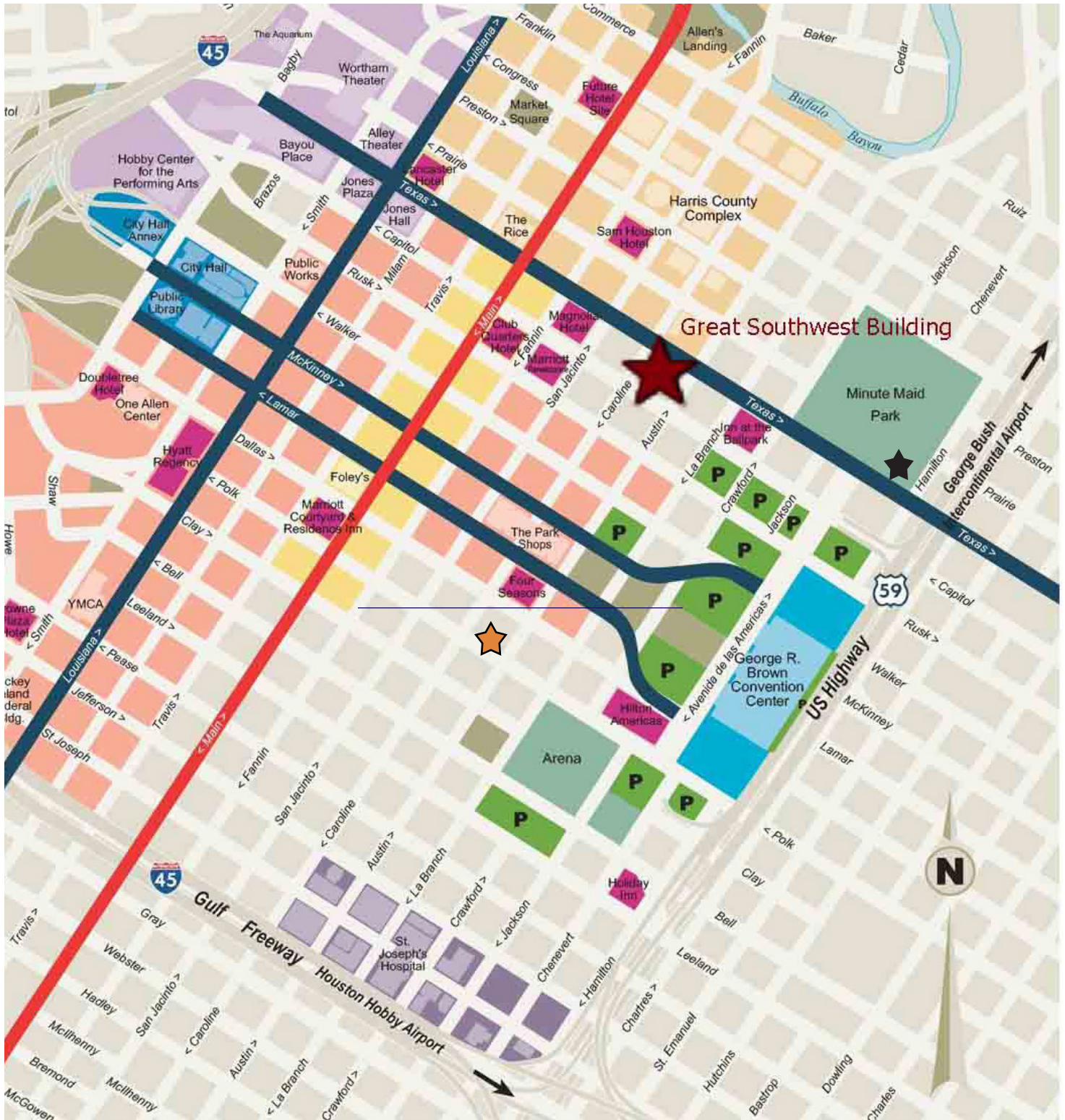
All cab rides anywhere within the Houston Downtown area are a flat \$5 charge.
