Dear Attorney General Bondi,

The undersigned local, state, and national organizations are writing to express our deep concern about the future of funding from the Department of Justice (DOJ) that has for decades formed the backbone of our nation's response to the crimes of domestic violence, dating violence, sexual assault, stalking and trafficking. This longstanding bipartisan commitment to supporting services and prevention efforts for victims of these crimes remains strong; however, the Department's recent actions have left these critical lifesaving programs uncertain about their ability to continue serving victims.

In February, Notices of Funding Opportunities (NOFOs) were withdrawn from the Office on Violence Against Women (OVW) website. These NOFOs are the primary way programs that rely on Violence Against Women Act (VAWA) funding apply for grants as appropriated by Congress. As you know, the Violence Against Women Act (VAWA) was recently reauthorized in 2022. In the FY 2025 Continuing Appropriations and Extensions Act, Congress appropriated \$715 million for VAWA grants intended to go out to grantees across the country by the end of this fiscal year. To date, there has been no information shared about when the NOFOs will be released.

Local, state, and national service providers have been anguished and panicked to receive recent notices terminating their federal grants. In addition, staff reductions at OVW are destabilizing for grantees.

Organizations funded by OVW and Office of Justice Programs (including Office for Victims of Crime) grants are community employers and many have very little funding in reserve to sustain their organizations. Without federal funding many of these organizations will close leaving communities less safe, with reduced access to victim services, law enforcement assistance, and prevention programs. Additionally, this uncertainty is causing workforce instability as rape crisis centers, domestic violence shelters, and other victim service agencies are local employers, conduct workforce development programs, and create job opportunities for victims of crime.

We are committed to and supportive of the important work of OVW and are additionally disheartened by the proposed [consolidation plan](#) aimed at drastically reducing the role of the office. OVW provides unique critical expertise and a dedicated independent voice within the federal government for victims of domestic violence, dating violence, sexual assault, and stalking. No other federal agency has both policy-making authority and also a direct connection to victim service providers and the individuals, families, and communities they serve. We

reemphasize the statutory language creating OVW as updated by Congress in 2022: “The Office [on Violence Against Women] shall be a separate and distinct office within the Department of Justice, not subsumed by any other office, headed by a Director, who shall report to the Attorney General and serve as Counsel to the Attorney General on the subject of violence against women, and who shall have final authority over all grants, cooperative agreements, and contracts awarded by the Office.” 34 U.S.C. § 10442

The terminations of grants, programmatic restructuring, loss of staff, disappearance of NOFOs, and lack of communication from DOJ to the field are causing grave insecurity and alarm across the nation among thousands of direct service providers, rape crisis centers, domestic violence shelters, culturally specific organizations, legal assistance providers, victim advocates, law enforcement agencies, and prosecutors offices.

Funding for victim services and prevention is a smart, high-impact investment that saves lives. The data is clear: Services reduce long-term costs, improve public health, and make communities safer. Research found that in its first five years, the Violence Against Women Act—prevented \$14.8 billion in victimization costs. Continuing to invest in a reliable, stable federal response to the crimes of domestic violence and sexual assault isn’t just the right thing to do—it’s a strategic move toward a healthier, more prosperous future where fewer lives are impacted by violence and communities remain safe.

We are asking for assurance that the Department of Justice is committed to continuing the work of OVW and continuing to administer authorized, appropriated federal funding at DOJ to support the nation’s response to domestic violence and sexual assault in a reliable, stable, and timely way.
