



DOMESTIC VIOLENCE COUNTS REPORT AMERICAN SAMOA SUMMARY

On September 10, 2025, **1 out of 1 (100%)** identified domestic violence programs in American Samoa participated in NNEDV’s Domestic Violence Counts Survey: a one-day, unduplicated count of adults and children seeking domestic violence services. Participating programs shared the following figures about the services they provided during the 24-hour survey period.

0 Victims Served

While programs did not shelter or house any victims on the survey day, funding is still required to keep these services available to survivors in need.

While no victims received non-residential supportive services on the survey day, these essential services still require funding to keep them available all year long.

0 Hotline Contacts Received

Domestic violence hotlines are lifelines for victims in danger, providing support, information, safety planning, and resources via phone, chat, text, email, and more. Programs need funding to keep their hotlines available.

0 People Educated

While programs did not provide educational sessions during this period, addressing topics like domestic violence prevention and early intervention are important throughout the year.

0 Unmet Requests for Services

While programs did not report any unmet requests during this period, there is still a tremendous need for increased funding to ensure programs can provide comprehensive services to all survivors seeking help while working toward preventing violence in their communities.
