



# DOMESTIC VIOLENCE COUNTS REPORT DELAWARE SUMMARY

On September 10, 2025, **2 out of 3 (67%)** identified domestic violence programs in Delaware participated in NNEDV's Domestic Violence Counts Survey: a one-day, unduplicated count of adults and children seeking domestic violence services. Participating programs shared the following figures about the services they provided during the 24-hour survey period.

### 223 Victims Served

**101** adults and children found refuge in emergency shelters, transitional housing, hotels, motels, or other housing provided by local programs.

**122** adults and children received non-residential supportive services like transportation, housing support, legal support, therapy, and more.

### 11 Hotline Contacts Received

Programs' hotlines received **11** contacts, averaging **nearly 1** contact per hour. Domestic violence hotlines are lifelines for victims, providing support, information, safety planning, and resources via phone, chat, text, email, and more.

### 0 People Educated

While programs did not provide educational sessions during this period, addressing topics like domestic violence prevention and early intervention are important throughout the year.

### 3 Unmet Requests for Services

Programs were unable to meet **3** requests for help because they lacked sufficient resources, funding, and/or staffing. Approximately **67%** of these unmet requests were for emergency shelter, hotels, motels, transitional housing, and other housing.
